

Transport and prices in Copenhagen Copenhagen

Tickets must be bought prior to boarding the train, while one time tickets can be bought on buses.

The ticket system is based on zones, examples:

Two zones from Airport to Hotel 9 Smaa Hjem

Two zones between Hotel 9 Smaa Hjem and DMI

Three zones from airport to DMI

Two zones between central Copenhagen and Hotel 9 Smaa Hjem.

Consider buying a ticket coupon, then you do not have to buy tickets all the time and it's cheaper.

Each punch card has 10 punches.

Blue card = two zones per punch DKK 130

Yellow card = three zones. DKK 170

Tickets are valid for a certain amount of time, normally one hour, on all trains and buses within the zones they give access to.

The yellow punch machines are located at train platforms and in buses..

If you prefer a taxi it will amount to about 350 DKK and will take ca. 45 minutes or more depending on the traffic to go from Airport to Hotel 9 Smaa Hjem and/or from Airport to DMI.
