

## **Finding your way to the hotel and CIENS building**

### **Finding your hotel:**

**From the airport I suggest that you take the express train to Oslo central station. The train is much faster and cheaper than taxi. (You may find it extremely expensive to enter a metered taxi on the airport!). From the central station you may walk, take a taxi or a tram.**

**Finding the Meteorological Institute, R&D Department  
From downtown Oslo you may take taxi, the tram or the subway (“T-bane”).**

**Coming with taxi: Ask the driver to take you to CIENS in Forskningsparken.**

**Coming with tram: Take line 17 or 18 direction “Rikshospitalet” and leave at “Forskningsparken”. Walk ahead for 50 m and turn left into construction road. Keep straight on until a bridge is overhead (150m) and turn right almost under the bridge into a preliminary walkway (construction site on both sides). Up the stairs and you have the main entrance in front of you.**

**Coming with subway: Take line 5 (direction “Storo”), line 4 (direction “Ringen”) or line 3 (direction “Sognsvann”) to “Forskningsparken”. Walk down the stairs and you are at the tram-stop. See above.**

**Note that there are major construction work going on.**
